### Three Speed Classes - Bronze, Silver and Gold

If you have never been to a scale Warbird race, you owe it to yourself to see what action-packed racing thrills are all about. The speed and close racing of these miniature Warbirds and Reno Racers are unmatched for viewing entertainment. Refreshment and food available at the SpeedWorld R/C field. From the corner of Bell Road and Grand Ave., go 7.4 miles Northwest on Grand Ave., turn left on Happy Valley Road. Go 1.4 miles to the Raceway Park on right. This is a AMA-sanctioned, RCPRO-endorsed event and is open to all AMA pilots. Friday March 21<sup>st</sup> is a normal flying day available for flying practice. Registration and safety inspections start 7:30 AM Saturday, racing starts at 8:30 AM. Fixed speed bracket format, Gold, Silver and Bronze classes, breakouts 1:30, 2:00 and 2:30 respectively. Backup airplanes must be on the same frequency. Trophies will be awarded for 3 places in each class. Profile aircraft are not allowed. **NOTE:** Due to the number of pilots expected, **you can fly in only one class**. However, there is a chance we will need additional aircraft to fill out a class. If this happens we may allow a few pilots to fly in two classes. The fee for an additional class is \$15.

### RCPRO Warbird Racing World Championship Series

This is the 1<sup>st</sup> race in the 2008 series. Races will be held in Kingman, AZ on 5/17 and 8/23. Races will be held in Victorville, CA on 4/19 and 9/20. After race at SpeedWorld on October 18<sup>th</sup>, the pilots with the most points in the three classes will be the 2008 RCPRO World Warbird Champions.
